Riebeek Cellars is proud to announce the release of its 2009 Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc and Pinotage Rosé. The Chenin Blanc is as tropical and fresh as ever and it stays the unofficial drink of the Riebeek Valley!

The Pinotage Rosé, made from Pinotage grapes especially grown for the making of Rosé wine is a delicate pink with an abundance of strawberries on the nose and a lovely crisp, dry palate.

It is however Riebeek's Sauvignon Blanc that earns a special mention. The 2009 is partly harvested from our BEE farm, Partnership Vineyards, and is probably the best one we have ever made. Winemaker, Eric Saayman, is very pleased and one can see him carrying home a few bottles every night.
